We recently became aware of your service, YouTube-mp3, which is being offered at\_www.youtube-mp3.org. It appears from your website and other marketing materials that YouTube-mp3 is designed to allow users to download content from YouTube. We need to ask you to stop offering that functionality.

You may be aware that the YouTube Terms of Service, which are posted at <a href="http://www.youtube.com/t/terms">http://www.youtube.com/t/terms</a>, prohibit the downloading of any video from the site that is not accompanied by a "download" link. In addition, your service violates the YouTube API Terms of Service, which are available at <a href="https://developers.google.com/youtube/terms">https://developers.google.com/youtube/terms</a>. For example, the API Terms of Service prohibit applications that "separate, isolate, or modify the audio or video components of any YouTube audiovisual content made available through the YouTube API," as well as applications that "store copies of YouTube audiovisual content." Continuing to violate these restrictions may result in legal consequences for you and/or your company.

We strive to keep YouTube a safe, responsible community, which requires compliance with the Terms of Service and API Terms of Service. We hope that you will cooperate with us by ceasing to offer YouTube-mp3 with functionality that downloads YouTube content within seven days from the date of this letter. Thank you in advance.
